By Underground


Waterloo is the nearest tube. Although Embankment, Westminster and Charing Cross are within walking distance.

By Car

Please note that there is extremely limited local parking facilities and driving is not recommended. Congestion charges apply until 6.30pm on weekdays if applicable for those coming by car.

Walking directions from Waterloo Station

Leave Waterloo Station / Underground via the "Waterloo Road" exit. Cross Waterloo Road and turn left, going towards the IMAX cinema roundabout and Waterloo Bridge. This will take you past St John's Church. When you reach the IMAX roundabout, take the right-hand turn into Stamford Street. This will take you past the King's College London James Clerk Maxwell Building, which is on the corner. The Franklin-Wilkins Building is number 150, Stamford Street – it is on the left-hand side as you walk away from the IMAX roundabout.

Directions for Franklin Wilkins Building from Waterloo

Come out of exit 5 (opposite the internal Eurostar entrance) go down the steps and into the subway on your left. Follow the path through the subway which will bring you out by the IMAX cinema. Follow signs to Stamford Street and Kings College (first exit right) and take the stairs up to your left. You should be on the corner of Stamford Street and Waterloo Road in front of the Post Office. Cross Stamford Street by the crossing at the top bringing you in front of Schiller University and walk down until you come to Franklin Wilkins Building (King's College London Banner down the side of the building).
