East Sussex Healthcare NHS Trust (ESHT) will be advertising via ORIEL several joint foundation year programmes with other sectors of practice in addition to its current 12 month secondary care programme.

Our local partners for the joint programmes include community pharmacy, GP practices and a Mental Health Trust.

Our one week summer placements for a total of 4 pharmacy undergraduates at Eastbourne General Hospital **weeks beginning June 27**th **and July 4**th are for those interested in undertaking all or part of their foundation year within ESHT and will provide an insight into the pharmacy department and the Trust

Successful applicants will be allocated to one of our multisector pharmacists whom will oversee the placement and be their supervisor. Opportunities during the placement include spending time with a range of health care professionals and prescribers as well as gaining an appreciation of the medicine optimisation processes required for the safe transfer of medicines across primary and secondary care.

The placement provides opportunities to undertake supervised learning events such as a Case Based Discussion and Medication Related Consultation Framework assessment.

Successful applicants would be expected to work between the hours of 9.00am and 5.30 pm, Monday to Friday, for the full week. It is important when you complete the application form that you specify your preference of placement week- either June 27th or July $4^{\rm th}$. Hospital accommodation may be available. Travel expenses will not be reimbursed.
